Joseph B. Hickey, III, died on Wednesday, July 17, 2019, at University of MD Shore Medical Center in Easton, MD. He was 51 years old.

He was born on December 2, 1967, in Baltimore, MD, the son of the late Joseph B. Hickey, Jr. and Arlene K. Langkam Hickey.

Joseph was employed at the Acme Supermarket in Easton as a Grocery Ambassador since 1989. He was a fixture in the Town of Easton; known to many as Tri, Sparky, Spark, or Joe. He projected his boundless love for his late mother, Arlene, onto others referring to many of his friends as "mom." He was well known for his care and generosity towards others. Joe found great pleasure in closely following the stock market, horse racing, watching professional sports and his favorite sports teams - Sabre, Warrior, and Boston Athletics. He greatly loved his family, especially his nieces. Joe received great love and support from his family and community and unselfishly gave back at every opportunity.

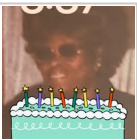
