



## Joseph Talfourd Logan

September 12, 1920 - August 31, 2014

Joe Logan was born September 12, 1920, in Harrisonburg, VA. He was the son of Madison College Professor Conrad T. Logan and Mary Jarman Logan.

As a young man he worked caring for horses at Camp Strawderman summer camp in VA where he met his future wife. He attended Randolph Macon College until the summer of 1943 when he enlisted as a private into the Army and attained the rank of Sergeant before being sent to one of the last Horse Cavalry OCS classes at Ft. Riley, Kansas. It was felt that the Japanese might try to hit the coast of Mexico and enter the U.S. along the southern border so he was assigned to the Texas border where he remained through the balance of the war.

In April of 1945, he married Mary Virginia McFarland of Greensburg, PA, a former riding instructor at Camp Strawderman. They moved to Easton, MD, in 1948 where Joe was employed by the USDA Grading Service which was still deeply involved in the tomato industry on the Eastern Shore. He retired from that in 1977.

He is remembered for his dedicated service to the Isaac Walton League and their nature area. He was also a member of Edge Creek Boat Club, a volunteer for Talbot Hospice and Habitat for Humanity.

His wife, Mary, died in 1998. Mr. Logan is survived by three children, his daughter, Susan L. Horwath of Centralia, WA; his sons, Colonel Joseph M. Logan of O'Fallon, IL, and Conrad T. Logan of Plantation, FL; four granddaughters, Justine Lelia Kethchie, Bethany Virginia Sorenson, Shauna Marie Miller and Adrienne Kay Gibbs; and ten great-grandchildren, Abigail Lelia Kethchie, Brayden Matthew Kethchie, Victoria Lucille Kethchie, Noelle Eileen Kethchie, Emmaline Sorensen, Joseph Andre Sorensen, Sarah Sorensen, Logan Aaron Miller, Jillian Miller and Jensen McFarland Gibbs.
