



Joseph Peter Makravitz

December 22, 1917 - April 25, 2016

Joseph P. Makravitz of Rock Hall, MD, formally of Westport CT, died on Monday, April 25, 2016, at the University of Maryland Shore Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in Chestertown, MD. He was 98.

Mr. Makravitz was born in Wilkes-Barre, PA, the son of the late Peter and Katherine Martin Makravitz.

Mr. Makravitz was a Machinist Supervisor for the DuPont Co., where he retired after 25 years of service. He was a member of the Church of the Assumption in Westport, CT, for over 70 years. Mr. Makravitz was an avid sports fan, especially enjoying the Boston Red Sox, and he loved watching the University of Connecticut Women's Basketball team.

He was a United States Army World War II veteran, serving in Germany.

In addition to his parents, Mr. Makravitz was predeceased by his wife, Blanche Reed Makravitz; a brother, Thomas, and a sister, Eleanor Penxa.

He is survived by two daughters, Judith L. Gallagher and Joan Lausman both of Rock Hall, MD; four grandchildren; and eight great-grandchildren.
