Joseph E. "Sonny" Nadolny of Church Hill, Maryland died on July 5, 2007 at Chester River Hospital Center. He was 79.

Born in Essex, Maryland on September 17, 1927 he was the son of the late Joseph John and Irene Grace Mell Nadolny.

Mr. Nadolny served in Essex with the Civil Defense in his younger years and served his country in the U.S. Army during World War II, from which he was honorably discharged. On September 28, 1947 he married Dorothy Mae Borgman, they moved to Kennedyville, Maryland, Chestertown, Maryland, and later settling in Church Hill, Maryland.

Mr. Nadolny owned and operated a farm where Chester Harbor, Chestertown, Maryland is now located, he also owned and operated several gas stations where he worked as a mechanic. He later drove a truck working for several years with Phil McDonald in Cordova, MD from which he retired in 1992. His wife predeceased him on March 3, 1992.

Mr. Nadolny was a member of the Frank M. Jarman American Legion Post #36 in Chestertown, MD a past member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Chestertown. He enjoyed his family first and foremost; he also loved people, his pets Freddie the beagle, and Blackie the rabbit, trucking stories, country music, and cardiac rehabilitation. He was seen by many walking through Church Hill, he was religious, a Good Samaritan, but a tough and fair man. He is survived by two sons: Joseph E. Nadolny, Jr. and his wife Janet of Barclay, MD and John M. Nadolny and his wife Dawn of Chestertown, MD,

two daughters: Linda C. Nadolny-Clough and her husband James of Barclay, MD, and Lori Ann Loughry of Chestertown, MD, four grandchildren: Meg Leigh Loughry, David Mathew Loughry, Jocelyn Rose Jackson and her husband James, and Joseph E. Nadolny III. He is also survived by a special sister in law: Rosalie E. Borgman of Church Hill, MD.
