Joseph M. Scalco of Stevensville, MD, passed away November 14. He was 58 years young. He was a loving husband and father whose life revolved around his family. He particularly enjoyed the opportunities the slower pace of life on the Chesapeake Bay's Eastern Shore provided to spend time with friends and family. He was very fond of social crab meals as they provided plenty of time to enjoy the company of loved ones.

Joe worked as a financial advisor in the Annapolis office of Transamerica Financial Advisors, Inc.

Scalco earned his Bachelor of Science in Marketing degree from the University of Maryland College Park in 1980 and graduated DeMatha Catholic High School 1975. He recently celebrated his 40th class reunion.

Born May 8, 1957, he was an avid sports fan, particularly concerning the University of Maryland Terrapins and Washington Redskins. He often attended games and enjoyed hosting viewing parties at his home in Stevensville. Joe also enjoyed playing golf and passed the occasional relaxed day with friends and co-workers.
