



Joseph Leonard Selby

May 9, 1940 - November 15, 2014

Joseph Leonard Selby of Church Hill, MD, died Saturday, November 15, 2014, at his home surrounded by his family. He was 74.

Born in Baltimore, MD, on May 9, 1940, he was the son of the late Bradley A. and Marie I. Blume Selby.

Joe grew up in Baltimore and was a graduate of Mergenthaler Vo-Tech High School where he enlisted in the Navy Reserves which led to active duty. After he was honorably discharged from the Navy, Joe began his career as a sheet metal worker with Eastern Venetian Blinds and later with the Board of Education for Baltimore City. Joe also worked for many years at Koons Ford in Baltimore and Annapolis as a mechanic until retiring. During his retirement on the Eastern Shore, he returned to work at the Centreville ACME where he was fondly called "Mr. Joe." Joe was a very patriotic man who enjoyed NASCAR, loved airplanes, especially the Blue Angels, and was a Ham radio operator, call sign "N3IVG."

He is survived by his wife of 26 years, Janice I. Spencer-Selby of Church Hill, MD; three daughters, Sherri Schroeder (Al) of Ocean City, MD, Susan Palecheck (Wayne) of Belair, MD, and Stephanie Selby of PA; a stepdaughter, Wendy Sardo of Church Hill, MD; a stepson, John Spencer (Sandra) of Glen Burnie, MD; five sisters, Margaret Pitarra, Marie Tumminello, Geraldine Allard,

Amelia Vavlis, and Elaine Postanowicz; a brother, Lou Selby; nine grandchildren; and one great-grandson. He was predeceased by two brothers, Bradley Selby, Jr. and Theodore Selby.

A visitation will be from 2-4 p.m. and 6-8 p.m. on Wednesday November 19, 2014, at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home in Centreville.
