



## Joseph Michael Stewart

November 22, 1945 - August 18, 2024

Joseph M. “Mike” Stewart, 78, of Easton, MD died Sunday August 18, 2024 at University of Maryland Shore Health at Easton following a short battle with cancer.

Born November 22, 1945, to Joseph Carl Stewart and Isabelle Stuart Chebonnier, Mike attended both Catholic and public school, graduating in 1963 from Wicomico High School in Salisbury. Following graduation, Mike was drafted into the Air Force during the Vietnam War where he proudly served his Country as an aircraft mechanic stationed in Thailand and Japan. Upon his return to the U.S. he continued his career in aircraft maintenance and went on to become an FAA inspector. The last 30 years of his career saw him working as the private mechanic for A.J. Clark at the Easton Airport. In his downtime he enjoyed drinking coffee, photography, watching Air Disasters on National Geographic, trains and drinking more coffee.

Never far from him were his beloved children, Jessica and Doug as well as his sister Mary Ann, Mike put his heart and soul into his family. Even after they divorced, he and his wife Linda, remained very close as they raised their children together. Later in life, Mike became Grandpa to his “Starshine” Emma who he planned to drive cross country in the Red Corvette he often talked about buying one day.

Preceded in death by his daughter Erica, mother Isabelle and father Joseph as well as other aunts and uncles, he is survived by his daughter Jessica Hackett and her husband Jimmy, son Douglas Stewart and his wife Jen, his granddaughter Emma Hackett, sister Mary Ann Mayer and her husband George, Linda Stewart, many cousins including Jay Cherbonnier and his neighbors who lovingly called him Wilson.
