Joseph Earl Whitby, Jr. (Buster), 77 of Hillsboro, MD, passed peacefully in his sleep on Tuesday, November 7, 2017, after a long illness.

He was born on March 25, 1940, to Joseph Earl Whitby, Sr. and Y. Louise Chance Whitby. He lived most of his life in Trappe, MD.

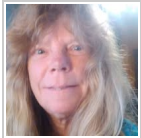

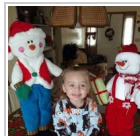
