May 15, 1925 - January 12, 2012

Joseph H. Yater, Jr., 86, of Trappe, MD, died on Thursday, January 12, 2012, at Memorial Hospital in Easton, MD.

Mr. Yater was born in Baltimore on May 15, 1925, son of the late, Joseph H. Yater and Hazel Florence Evans Yater. In 1943, following high school graduation in Cranford, NJ, Mr. Yater enlisted in the United States Marine Corps and went on to serve in the South Pacific. He was employed by CIBA for many years in New Jersey and California. He was a salesman of marine supplies with several companies on the Eastern Shore.

He was a former member of the American Legion Post #70 and the VFW Memorial Post #5118, both in Easton.

Mr. Yater is survived by a son, Joseph F. Yater and his wife, Debbie of Trappe; a daughter, Joan M. Yater of St. Michaels; a sister, Sallie Ann Yater of Easton; and two grandchildren, Joseph Zachary Yater and Kelsey Lynn Yater. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, Eleanor M. Yater, who died January 9, 2001, and a sister, Hazel Ruth Yater Oxee.

A funeral service will be held on Tuesday, January 17, 2012, at 2 p.m. at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A. in Easton where friends may call one hour prior to the service.
