A Funeral Liturgy for Joseph Edward “Joe” Diamond, Sr. will be celebrated at Sts. Peter & Paul Catholic Church in Easton on Tuesday, March 30, 2004 at 11:00 AM. Mr. Diamond died at his home in Easton on Friday March 26, 2004. He was 81.

Born December 1, 1922 in Philadelphia, PA, he was the 8th of 21 children of the late Edward Joseph, Sr. and Marguerite Lennon Diamond. After attending public school in Philadelphia, he resided there until 1940. He moved to Baltimore, MD and worked for Glenn L. Martin Aircraft Co. until serving in the U.S. Navy during World War II. During his time in the service he was assigned to the battleship U.S.S. Indiana and was in Tokyo Bay at the signing of the treaty ending World War II. During the time that he served, he received nine major battle stars. While serving in the Navy he married the former Augusta Haddaway. Following his release from active duty in 1945, they moved to the St. Michaels area. Mr. Diamond was a renowned meat cutter with several grocery stores throughout Maryland, retiring in 2003 at the age of 80.

A member of Sts. Peter & Paul Catholic Church, Easton, he was also a life member of E.E. Streets Post #5118 V.F.W. where he served as Post Commander from 1986-1987 and was a member of the Color Guard. He was a member of American Legion Post #70 and a 3rd Degree Cheli Councill #2247 Knights of Columbus.

Mr. Diamond is survived by five children; Darlene Lurz of Pasadena, Jo Ann Diamond-Gay of Easton, Joseph E. Diamond, Jr. of Greencastle, PA, Margaret Diamond of Pasadena and Patti Diamond of St. Michaels; eleven grandchildren and fifteen great grandchildren.

Burial will be at the Maryland Eastern Shore Veterans Cemetery, Hurlock, MD.
