Joseph G. Lawrence of St. Michaels died at Memorial Hospital in Easton on Saturday, November 1, 2003. He was 70.

Born in New York City on March 11, 1933, he was the son of the late Florence Campbell. He grew up in the New York City area where he attended public school. Following his graduation in 1951, he enlisted in the United States Navy. After being honorably discharged in 1955 he returned to New York where he worked as a conductor for the Long Island Railroad. Following his retirement in 1988, he and his wife moved to Seattle, Washington. Mrs. Lawrence, the former Henrietta Matazinski died in 1999. In 2001 he moved to St. Michaels.

He was a member of the Miles River Yacht Club.
