



Joseph George Pecosh

April 23, 1933 - March 29, 2009

Joseph Pecosh of Chester, MD died on Sunday, March 29, 2009 at his home surrounded by his loving family. He was 75.

Born on April 23, 1933, the son of Joseph and Stella Pecosh of Edenborn, PA, he graduated from Germantownship High School in 1951. He was an outstanding athlete playing baseball, football, and basketball where he held the record of the most points scored during a high school career. He joined the Army in 1953 and was honorably discharged in 1955 during which he traveled throughout Europe playing baseball for the Army. He met and married Elizabeth Konosky in 1956. She preceded him in death in 2007. Mr. Pecosh owned and operated gas stations and restaurants in the Washington, D.C. and Crofton, MD areas. In 1998, he moved to Kent Island to retire.

Prior to his retirement, he was an avid golfer. Upon his retirement, he enjoyed cooking, watching football and loved spending time with his family and Molly, the family dog.

Mr. Pecosh is survived by 3 daughters, Marcia Halinka and her husband Jim of Annapolis, MD, Patricia Baldwin of Crofton, MD, and Karen Kelleher of Chester, MD; son, Joseph Pecosh of Odenton, MD; 2 sisters, Mildred Doscher of Pittsburgh, PA and Irene Oleyash of Falls Church, VA; 13 grandchildren; and 5 great grandchildren. He is preceded in death by his wife, Elizabeth

Pecosh; 4 brothers; 3 sisters; and 1 great granddaughter.
