Joseph H. Oldham, 72 yrs, of Cecilton, MD died on June 1st, 2001 at Union Hospital of Cecil County in Elkton.

A life long resident of Cecilton, he was the son of the late George W. & Pearl M. [Woodall] Oldham. He was a graduate of the George Biddle High School in Cecilton and after graduation he embarked on a career in carpentry. He loved working with wood and has left his mark on a lot of the homes in the Cecilton area. In 1948 he entered the United States Army, where he served as an instructor in the Radio Division. He was honorably discharged in 1952.

He lived in Elkton, MD for a short period of time and then returned to Cecilton. He worked for Raymond Weed, and his last employ was with Bay Boat Works in North East, MD. He was a past member of the Loyal Order of the Moose in Elkton, and a past member of the American Legion. In his spare time he enjoyed helping his friends with carpentry projects, and raising vegetables in his garden.

In addition to his parents, his wife Rachel [Mason] Oldham, a son Richard J. Oldham who died in March of 2001, a daughter Nan Elizabeth Oldham and a sister Virginia Snyder, precedes Mr. Oldham in death. He is survived by a daughter Ginger L.
