Josephine Niemczuk, 91, a resident of Annapolis for more than a year and formerly of Glen Burnie, MD and Elizabeth, NJ, died of cancer July 23 at the Heritage Harbour Center.

Born July 5th 1916 in West Orange, NJ, she moved to the Ukraine with her parents Wasyl and Rosalia Wandrowicz in 1922. Josephine returned to the United States in 1936 where she worked as a domestic with several families in Newark, NJ.

She was the widow of John Niemczuk who she married July 27, 1941 and who died 9/18/92.

She was employed at the RCA manufacturing plant then located in Harrison, NJ for over 25 years, retiring as a quality control inspector in 1972.

She and her late husband, John, were members of St. John's Ukrainian Catholic Church in Newark, NJ, and volunteers in church fund raising activities.

Her interests included cooking, Polish and Ukrainian dishes and traditions, needlework, and animals of all kinds, especially the family pets who were all rescue.

Surviving is her son, John Niemczuk, of Annapolis, MD; two grandchildren, Catherine Niemczuk - Hepler of Odenton, MD, and Jack Niemczuk of Kensington, MD; and two great-grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her brother.

A memorial service will be held at St. Joseph's Roman Catholic Church, 1283 Odenton Road, Odenton, MD 21113, on Friday, August 3, 2007 at 10:30 a.m. Interment will be private.
