Josephine V. Jewell of Easton formerly of Queenstown, died at Genesis ElderCare the Pines on Friday, January 24, 2003. She was 84.

Born in Crum, West Virginia on January 1, 1919, she was the daughter of the late William J. and Florence Brown Varney. In 1942 she moved to Maryland where she worked in the munitions plant at Galena, Md. during WWII. In 1943 she met and married Charles Franklin Jewell of Crumpton, Md. they moved to Queenstown in 1949. Mrs. Jewell worked for Rob Roy Sewing Factory in Ridgely, and retired after 27 years of service. Rob Roy was owned by Roy Rogers whom she once met. Mr. Jewell died in July 1987.

Mrs. Jewell was a member of the Calvary United Methodist Church, Queenstown, Md. where she was a member of the choir, Sunday school teacher, Sunday school Superintendent, Board member, past President of the MWMS, as well as helping with Vacation Bible School. She always helped with the Ham and Oyster Dinners and the Lions Club Dinners. She was also well known for her lemon meringue and cherry pies.

Mrs. Jewell is survived by a daughter Barbara Cheezum and son-in-law William N. Cheezum of Cordova, Md. A grand-daughter Cynthia Scaglione and grandson-in-law Christopher T. Scaglione, of Cordova, Md; a grandson, William N. Cheezum III of Queenstown; three sisters, Opal, Muriel and

Gladys; one brother, David; great grandson, Andrew and great granddaughter, Sarah.
