Joseph Leon Warring of Selbyville, DE died Sunday, May 23, 2004 at Memorial Hospital of Easton. He was 88.

Born on May 11, 1916 in Washington, DC, he was the son of the late James T. and Martha Danforth Warring. He graduated from St. Anthony's High School, class of 1936. On May 25, 1939 he married the former, Theresa C. Maulding of Washington, D.C. Mr. Warring started working with his father at James T. Warring and Son's Barrell Business on South Capital Street in Washington, D.C. He later began a career in property management for B.F. Saul Company. When he retired in 1974, he was Secretary of the Board of Directors. He moved to Mayo, MD and shortly afterward to Ocean City, MD. While in Ocean City, he began the after school stamp collecting program for many students with the local school system and became known as "Pop Pop the Stampman of Ocean City."

Mr. Warring is survived by two sons, J. Michael Warring of Queenstown, MD and James T. Warring II of West River, MD; one daughter, Eileen Warring Harper of Selbyville, DE; one brother, Vincent Warring of Waldorf, MD; six grandchildren, Joseph Michael Warring, Jr. of Warrenton, VA, Stephanie Marie Wilson and Michael Alexander Warring, both of Silver Spring, MD, Catherine E.
