Joseph Sewell Horney of Easton, MD died on Wednesday, April 25, 2007 at Talbot Hospice House, Easton. He was 84.

Born August 19, 1922 in McDaniel, MD, he was the son of the late Joseph and Etta Sewell Horney. After graduating from St. Michaels High School in 1939, he went to Southern California for aircraft maintenance training that concluded with training at Glen L. Martin in Baltimore. From 1942-1946 he served in the U.S. Army Air Corp. In 1946 he took a position with C. Albert Matthews as a sheet metal mechanic where he remained until retiring in January of 2007.

A member of St. Mark's United Methodist Church in Easton, he was also a 60+ year member of Granite Lodge #177 in St. Michaels, and was very active with Boy Scout Troop 190 as committee chairman.

His wife, Ernestine Barrett Horney, whom he married June 28, 1952, died August 12, 1993.

Mr. Horney is survived by three children, William Horney of Easton, Joanne Drummer and her husband Dan of Centreville, and Barbara Wood and her husband Phil of Cordova; a sister, June Weems of Royal Oak; and eight grandchildren, Michael, Christopher, Nicholas, and Mollie Horney of Easton,

Amanda and Gregory Drummer of Centreville, and Jake and Matthew Wood of Cordova.
