



## Joseph T. Hoskins

April 17, 1927 - July 6, 2010

Joseph Thomas Hoskins of Rock Hall, MD died on Tuesday July 6, 2010 at his home in Rock Hall after a short illness. He was 83.

He was born April 17, 1927 in Price Hill, West Virginia the son of the late, Thomas and Mercy Ella Thomas Hoskins. Mr. Hoskins graduated Mount Hope High School. During his career he drove several buses in West Virginia, a trolley and bus service in Wilmington, Delaware and drove a truck for the DuPont Corporation until his retirement from the Teamsters Local 312 in 1988. Mr. Hoskins continued to drive a truck for Annie J's Seafood and Ford's Seafood in Rock Hall, MD until June of this year. He and his wife were boaters in Rock Hall from the early 1950's and then moved to Rock Hall in 1967.

In addition to his wife, Ruth Ella who predeceased him in 2004, he is also predeceased by two sons, Joseph Gordon Hoskins and Joseph Malcolm Hoskins.

He is survived by two daughters, Rebecca Clark and her husband, Chucky of Rock Hall, MD, Elizabeth Jackson and her husband, Bert of Parsons Island, MD; two granddaughters, Tracey Clark Nicholson of Chestertown, MD and Crystal Clark Leager of Kennedyville, MD; two great grandchildren, Alicin and Stephanie Leager. He is also survived by three daughters from his first marriage, Sara Bryson of Roanoke, VA, Susan Ojala of Uniontown, OH and

Betsy Evans of Arlington, TX; ten grandchildren, many great grandchildren and one great great grandchild. One daughter-in-law Diane Hoskins of Houlton, ME also survives.
