



## Joseph W. Zwobot

Joseph William Zwobot of Queenstown, MD died Wednesday, June 9, 2004 at his residence. He was 83.

Born on November 22, 1920 in Union City, NJ, he was the son of the late Margaret Popp and Joseph Zwobot. Joseph grew up in Union City, NJ and was a graduate of Union City High School and he attended Columbia University and obtained a B.S. in Engineering. During WWII, Joseph was an engineer for a shipyard where they gave him the nickname "Gerter". On January 19, 1947, he married Mabel Ruth and they resided in Pikesville, MD where he worked as a construction engineer with Crane & Crane and Holiday Universal. He retired to his retreat in Harper's Ferry, WV on Lake Shannondale. About 18 years ago, Joseph and Mabel moved to Queenstown, MD.

He was a Commander in the Coast Guard Auxiliary and was the oldest person to pass the Auxiliary Exam. He was also a recruiter and assisted recruits preparing for enlistment into the Coast Guard Auxiliary. He enjoyed hunting and fishing. He was an enthusiastic gun collector and was on rifle teams. He was a Chesapeake Bay conservationist, always concerned for the protection of the Bay.

In addition to his wife of 57 years, Mabel, he is survived by four children,
