EASTON: Joseph William Hines of Easton, formerly of Bridgeport, CT, died peacefully at his home on Saturday, July 25, 2009 with the aid of Talbot Hospice, and his wife and children by his side. He was 70.

Born in Bridgeport, CT on April 29, 1939, he was the son of the late William Joseph and Angelina Marella Hines. He was a 1957 graduate of Stratford High School in Stratford, CT. He served in the Air Force from 1959-1960, during the Korean War. He married Judith A. Firmender on November 23, 1961.
