Joshua Jon Rediger of Chester, MD, died on Saturday, May 24, 2014. He was 22.

Josh was born April 12, 1992, in Washington, DC. He lived the first ten years of his life in the Clinton, MD, area. He attended Independent Baptist Academy, Salisbury Baptist Academy, A Beka Academy Home School. He graduated from high school in 2010 and completed one semester of college at Champion Baptist in Hot Springs, AR.

As a child, he placed his faith in Jesus Christ and now he is in heaven: John 3:16 "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life."

He moved to the Eastern Shore of Maryland along with his family in 2002. He started two small businesses: one at the age of twelve, "JR's Lawn Service," with a riding mower he purchased with his own money and the other, MAD, (Mobile Auto Detail). He loved to work and often had two jobs at the same time: Papa John's, Safeway, Lowery's Produce, Adam's Ribs, Wido Construction, Jeff's Body Shop, and Pintail Point. He recently made a career change to Blades of Green where he was excited about the opportunity to grow.

He grew up in a pastor's home and embraced who he was, which is reflected by his Facebook cover photo "Son of a Preacher Man." He loved the Eastern Shore and he enjoyed playing his guitar, guns, fishing and working with his hands.

Through the years many wonderful people had a part in shaping this man's life, including family, friends, youth leaders, teachers, pastors, church members, fellow students, bosses and coworkers.

He earned the respect of those who knew him best, through the very real, honest and sincere way he viewed life. Josh was always known to be a hard worker and grew to be a man of character and compassion. We would often hear him say "I'm living the dream!" He embraced, enjoyed and was very thankful for his life, his family and his friends. He loved people and he was very open about his faith, as a result, his life has touched the lives of many.

Survived by his father and mother Jon and Stephanie Rediger; one sister, Elizabeth "Liz" Rediger all of Chester, MD; paternal grandparents, Jon and Barb Rediger of Morton, IL; maternal grandparents, William and Shirley Camburn of Paw Paw, MI; paternal great grandfather, Eugene Seets of Morton, IL; and many, many cousins, aunts, and uncles.
