Joy String passed away Sunday, May 27, 2012 at the Talbot Hospice House in Easton, MD. She was 70 years old. Joy was born July 7, 1941 in Woodbury, N.J. to the late Jeannette (Smylie) String and Charles Henry String. She was a 1959 graduate of Millville Memorial High School, in Millville, NJ. During her senior year, she attended The Philadelphia Modeling and Charm School. Upon graduation, Joy was employed by Owens Illinois Glass Company, Bridgeton, N.J. for the summer. She then attended Montclair State College and the following year went to the Airline Training School in Hartford, CT. She moved to Arlington, VA., and worked in the Secretarial Pool at the Pentagon. After a few years, she had an extensive career as an Airline Reservationist working for United Airlines, Ransom Airlines (purchased by Pan Am in 1986), Trans Caribbean Airlines and KLM. Joy loved traveling and took every opportunity to travel while working for the airlines. She made several overseas trips to Europe, Hawaii, Alaska, Asia, and across the U. S. She enjoyed her many friends and co-workers in D. C., Northern VA area, and Atlanta, GA. One of her most memorable times was when she took a balloon ride while residing in Atlanta, Ga.

In 1991, Joy moved to Easton, MD from Atlanta, GA and worked for the Dixon House becoming certified as a Medication Aide in 1999. She worked for the Dixon House for 9 years retiring in 2006 due to health issues.

Left to cherish her memory are her sisters, Janice Lawson of Waco, TX; Judith Musch (Robert) of Easton, MD; and Jeri Hall of Italy, TX; brothers, Charles H.
