Joyce Ann Prah of Cambridge, MD, went to be with her Lord Sunday, June 14, 2015. She was born in Easton, MD, on September 8, 1939, to the late Raymond Stewart and late Mildred Warren. Joyce grew-up in Royal Oak, MD, and was a member of the 1957 graduating class of St. Michael's High School.

On September 21, 1957, she married William "Bill" Prah of Andrews, MD. They lived in Royal Oak, in their early married years having three children, later moving to Cambridge. She retired from Triangle Oil Company in Easton in 2003 after 45 years of service.

As a youth and young adult, you could find her walking the shores of the Eastern Bay crabbing or on the water sailing. Later she enjoyed camping in their RV, and was a member of the Happy Hour Gang camping group. She touched many people with her crocheting, giving her wares to family and friends in the neighborhood.
