Joyce W. Taylor of Easton died on Friday, January 23, 2009 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. She was 82.

Born July 15, 1926 in Easton she was the daughter of the late Charles B. and Mary Helen Hubbard Walls. She was a 1943 graduate of Easton High School. Following graduation she worked as a telephone operator for C & P Telephone Company. During World War II she traveled to Army camps throughout Maryland, where she served as a telephone operator to support the war effort. She attended Mary Washington College in Fredericksburg, VA. On May 14 1949, she married Norris E. Taylor; in Easton together they formed a successful contracting & concrete business. At the time of her death, Mrs. Taylor was Vice President of N.E. Taylor Contractors, Inc. of Easton.

She was a member of various organizations including St. Mark's United Methodist Church where she was a circle member and a former Sunday School teacher.

In addition to her husband Mrs. Taylor is survived by three children; Lorraine Claggett and her husband Laurence, Jr. of Easton, Patricia Goodman and her husband Jeffery of Alexandria, VA, Norris E. Taylor, Jr. and his wife Shelly of Easton; two sisters, Elizabeth "Betty" Walls Cooper of Salisbury, MD and Roxanna Walls Macindoe of Easton; and six grandchildren, Katie, Sarah,

Caroline, Michael, Laura and Matthew. In addition to her parents she was predeceased by a brother, Charles B. Walls, Jr. and twin sons, William and Howard.

A funeral service will be held on Friday, January 30, 2009 at 2:00 PM at Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P. A., Easton where friends may call on Thursday from 6 to 8 PM and Friday from 1 to 2 PM.
