



## Judith Hunsicker Burr

November 22, 1935 - November 7, 2024

Helen Judith “Judy” Hunsicker Burr passed away peacefully on November 7, 2024, at the age of 88. She lived a beautiful life filled with a love of art, sailing, travel, and family.

Born in Philadelphia on November 22, 1935, Judy was the daughter of the late Dr. William and Helen Hunsicker. She attended Germantown Friends School, graduating with the class of 1953, before going on to graduate from Centenary School in Hackettstown, New Jersey. Growing up, Judy spent her summers on the North East River at Hances Point, where she met her late husband, John C. “Jack” Burr. Jack and Judy married in 1956 and settled in Wilmington, Delaware, where they raised their growing family.

Judy often fondly reminisced about the summers at Hances Point. She recalled the entire family, which included four children and at least one golden retriever, piling into the Chevy station wagon on the first day of summer break to make the trek from Wilmington to the river. She remembered how her children, often barefoot, would leap out of the back of the car as soon as they arrived. Over time, Hances Point became affectionately known as “Camp Burr,” and Judy spent countless summers watching generations of children swim and leap from her dock at high tide. These precious memories, along with her extensive travels and her deep love for family, were the inspiration for dozens, if not hundreds, of paintings throughout her lifetime. Her works of art will be forever cherished by many.

Judy was preceded in death by Jack, her husband of over 60 years, and by

her beloved son, John C. Burr, Jr. She is survived by her son, William A. Burr (Rosa) of Ft. Lauderdale, Florida; daughters, Elizabeth Keefe (Tim) and Barbara Leonard (Mark) of Chestertown, Maryland; four grandchildren, Patrick McMullen, Allison Burr Hicks, Jacqueline Jablecki, and Emily Armstrong; and six great-grandchildren: Jackson McMullen, Liam McMullen, Lucy McMullen, Charlotte Burr Jablecki, Holden Burr Hicks, and Theodore Francis Hicks.
