Judith A. Dailey of Chester, MD passed away of natural causes at her home on Wednesday, January 24, 2007. Judy, as she was known to her friends and family, was 62 years old.

Born on February 23, 1944 in Palm Beach, FL, Judy was the daughter of James J. Dailey and the late Katharine K. Dailey. Judy attended junior college at Georgetown Visitation and obtained her college degree in interior design from Mount Vernon College, both in Washington, D.C.

Highlights of Judy's career included her tenures as an interior designer for the General Services Administration and later at the National Archives during which time she obtained an Executive Masters in Business Administration from the George Washington University. Most recently, she held the position of branch chief at the Department of Housing and Urban Development.

Judy raised her family in the Washington, D.C. area and then relocated to Maryland's Eastern Shore in 1996, initially living in Stevensville and later in Chester in the Bayside community. Judy was a member of Christ Episcopal Church in Stevensville and she had the honor of serving on the Board of the Archives of the Episcopal Church. She was extensively involved with the relocation of the national church's archives and made periodic trips to Austin, TX for board meetings.

Judy is survived by her father James J. Dailey of Naples, FL, her brother Brennan W. Dailey also of Naples, FL, her four beloved daughters Francesca R. Ryan of Bethesda, MD, Christina L. Repetti of Adelaide, Australia, Katharine R. Roberts of Atlanta, GA and Marisa C. Repetti of Fairfax, VA, and her two grandsons Charles F. Roberts and J. Colin Roberts of Atlanta, GA.
