Judith Warner Tieder of Easton died at the Memorial Hospital, Easton on Friday, April 15, 2005 from complication of pneumonia. She was 69.

Born in Easton, on October 29, 1935 she was the daughter of the late Lloyd W. and Dorothy Shubkagel Warner. Following her graduation from Easton High School, she married John K. Ross; in 1954, together they owned and operated East End Liquors and then Startt's Market in Easton. Later she took a position with the State of Maryland Unemployment Office as a case worker where she remained for over 20 years until her retirement in 1996. In 1979 she married John "Mickey" Tieder, they made their home in Easton, before moving to Chincoteague, Va. Mr. Tieder died in 2003. In 2004 Mrs. Tieder returned to Easton, where she enjoyed spending time with her granddaughter and her miniature daschund, and constant companion "Trudy".

Since returning to Easton Mrs. Tieder was very active in the Hyde Park community. In addition to the Hyde Parkers, she was a member of the Ladies of the Moose lodge 1520.

Mrs. Tieder is survived by a daughter, Sharon R. Shortall and her husband Robert of Royal Oak; a sister Phyllis "Polly" Patrick of Easton; one granddaughter, Katelyn Shortall; four cousins, Patricia Covey and her husband Jim, Lee Royer and her husband Gary, Audrey Henry and her

husband Jimmy and Joyce McNeil; six nieces and nephews, Stanley Patrick and his wife Doreen, Stephen Patrick and his wife Nancy, Michael Patrick, Robin Patrick, Dawn Watts and her husband Gary, Patti Dentel and her husband Lance, she is also survived by her former husband John K. Ross. She was predeceased by a nephew Joseph Patrick.
