



Judson Williams Jr.

On Tuesday, August 31, 2004 Judson Thomas Williams died at Chester River Manor after a short illness. He was 82.

He was the son of the late Judson T. Williams MD of Colorado Springs, CO and Geraldine Vickers Wilmer, R.N. of Chestertown, Maryland. Born in 1922 in Colorado Springs, he attended Cheyenne Mountain School before moving to Baltimore graduating from City College in 1940. He then entered Washington College in Chestertown for two years before enlisting in the US Army Air Force in 1942. He participated in the campaigns of Normandy, Northern France and the Rhineland as a photographic analyzer in the 9th Air Force, which supported the 3rd Army. Honorably discharged in 1945 he returned to Washington College and participated in football and basketball for the Sho'men until graduating in 1948 with a BS in chemistry.

Judson settled his family in Bethesda, MD for almost 30 years working for Read Plastics as General Sales Manager before retiring in 1986. During this period he coached youth baseball, basketball and football teams that produced many collegiate athletes. Upon retiring he returned to Chestertown where he enjoyed gardening, hunting and playing bridge with his many friends and family.

Mr. Williams is survived by his wife, Dorothy Riedy Williams of Chestertown;

two sons, William Noble Williams of Houston, TX and Judson Thomas Williams III, his wife Shirley, and two grandchildren of North Potomac, MD.

A memorial service will be held at Old St. Paul's Kent Episcopal Church, Chestertown, MD on Friday, September 3, 2004 at 2:00 PM with interment immediately following.
