Jules Jack Shinberg of Chestertown, Md. died on September 13, 2001 at Kent and Queen Anne's Hospital. He was 89.

Born on March 24, 1912 in Philadelphia, Pa., he was the son of the late Bernard and Pearl Kaiser Shinberg.

Mr. Shinberg graduated from Collingdale High School Class of 1930 and attended West Chester University. He served in the U.S. Navy Seabees from 1943 until his honorable discharge in 1945. Returning to Pennsylvania, he worked with Sinclair Oil Refinery, which later became B.P. Oil. He resided in Yeadon, Pa. and later Eddystone, Pa. In January of 1977 he retired as Personnel Director with B.P. and in 1979 moved to Chestertown, Md. During this period in his life he worked on a consulting basis for Wheaton Glass in Vineland, N.J.

Mr. Shinberg was a member of the Artisan and B.P. Quarter Century Club. In addition to his wife of 37 years: Lavoura M. Shinberg of Chestertown, Md., he is survived by 2 sons: Hugh Shinberg of Parsippany, NJ. and Robert Hancox of Eddystone, Pa., and 2 grandchildren: David Hancox and Brian Hancox. One son the late Howard Hancox along with a brother, the late George Shinberg both predeceased him.
