February 5, 1931 - September 9, 2017

Julia A. Flanagan died on Saturday, September 9, 2017, at The University of Maryland Shore Medical Center in Easton, MD. She was 86.

Julia was born on February 5, 1931, to parents, John Joseph Collins and Helen (Archer) Collins in New York, NY.

Julia attended St. Elizabeth College in Convent Station, NJ. Before moving to Easton, she lived in Newtown, CT, and Sea Girt, NJ. She was self-employed as an Interior Designer and taught a continuing education course in Interior Design at Chesapeake College in Wye Mills, MD. Julia was a member of the St. Michaels Women's Club.
