April 12, 1917 - January 8, 2010

On January 8, 2010, Julia Curlett Hopkins of Betterton, Maryland went home to be with our Lord, after residing at Crofton Care and Rehabilitation Center in Crofton, Maryland for the past two and a half years. She was 92 years old.

Julia was born in Barclay, Maryland on April 12, 1917, the daughter of the late, George and Martha (nee Williams) Curlett. She worked in Baltimore at Glen L. Martin Airplane Factory where she was a "Rosie the Riveter". She was also the manager of the Betterton Elementary School Cafeteria until her children were out of high school, and retired from McCord's Dry Cleaning in Chestertown in 1994.

Julia enjoyed baking, crocheting, embroidery, and spending time with her family. She was an active member of the Betterton United Methodist Church.

She is preceded in death by her beloved husband, Ray G. Hopkins, whom she married on June 5, 1937, and her three brothers and one sister.

She was the devoted mother of Julia Patricia Schuyler (and her husband Wesley) of Denton, MD, and Ray George Hopkins (and his wife Sandra) of Crownsville, MD. She was the loving grandmother of Chris Leager, Annette Moore, Wade Leager, and Martha Sidlowski, and was blessed with six great grandchildren.
