Julia Gardner Eaton of Kent Island died Thursday, November 18, 2004 at Memorial Hospital in Easton. She was 86.

Born on October 3, 1918 on Kent Island, she was the daughter of the late, Tilghman Ogle Eaton and Maggie Gardner Eaton. She graduated from Stevensville High School in 1936. During World War II, she moved to Baltimore to work on the domestic war front for the U.S. Naval Projects at Bendix. After the war, she returned to the Eastern Shore and began work for the State of Maryland, working for the Maryland State Toll Facilities and the State Comptroller's Office for 28 years.

Ms. Eaton was a lifelong member of Christ Church Parish, Kent Island. She enjoyed knitting and will long be remembered for her sweaters and Christmas stockings donated to charitable fundraisers and given to friends over many years. She also enjoyed her nieces, nephews, grandnieces and grandnephews as well as all children with whom she had contact.

She is survived by a sister, Ruth Eaton Foster and brother-in-law, Carlton Foster of Grasonville, MD; a nephew she raised, William R. Eaton of Chester, MD; a niece and namesake, Julia Eaton of Chester, MD and nephew Michael R. Foster of Grasonville, MD and grandnieces, Morgan Elizabeth Foster and Claire McClymonds Foster and grandnephew Jared Wall.
