Julian Thomas Robinson of Tolchester, Chestertown, MD, died on May 20, 2003, at Maryland General Hospital in Baltimore, MD. He was 82.

Born in Still Pond, MD, on July 19, 1920, he was the son of the late Ernest and Sarah Newcomb Robinson. He was a 1938 graduate of Chestertown High School and in 1943 he married the former, Virginia Ethel Kuhn.

In August of 1944, Mr. Robinson enlisted in the U.S. Army and served during WWII in the European African Middle Eastern Theatre. He was honorably discharged in April of 1946. Returning to Maryland, he took a job as a Baltimore City Police officer in 1948 and worked until his retirement. Upon his retirement he and his wife moved to Tolchester near Chestertown, MD.

On October 31, 1999, his wife of 56 years predeceased him.

He was a member of the Fraternal Order of Police and was active in the Tolchester Community Association. He also enjoyed amateur radio operation.

Mr. Robinson is survived by a son, Robert Robinson of Baltimore, MD; a brother, Ernest Robinson of Baltimore, MD; a sister, Betty Kerr of Baltimore, MD; three grandchildren, Michael Constantino of Baltimore, MD, Angela Constantino of Baltimore, MD and Donna Boone of Rising Sun, MD; and three

great- grandchildren, Ashley Boone, Jessica Boone, and Jonathon Boone. One daughter, Gloria Constantino, predeceased him in 1998.

Funeral services will be held on Friday, May 23, 2003, at 1:00 P.M., at Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., 130 Speer Road, Chestertown, MD, where relatives and friends may call on Thursday, May 22, 2003, between the hours of 6:00 and 8:00 P.M.
