The family then moved to Rockville, MD, in 1965 where Julie attended middle and high school graduating from Richard Montgomery High School. She continued her education with college courses but gravitated into the workforce at the Hecht company in an administrative position.

In 1981, she moved on to the C&P Telephone Co. of MD as a field technician. As she progressed, C&P became Bell Atlantic and eventually Verizon. Julie was promoted to a supervisory position and later retired from Verizon in 2003.
