Juliet Tilghman Berry Slaughter, beloved mother, grandmother and great-grandmother, died peacefully on Tuesday, July 20, 2004 at the Villa Rosa Nursing Home in Mitchellville, MD. She was 96.

Born December 27, 1907 in Wilkes Barre, PA, she was the daughter of the late Joseph Kennard and Anne Wray Tipping Berry. At a young age, she moved to Queenstown, MD where she attended school and then graduated from Centreville High School. In 1928 she married Leo M. Slaughter of Longwoods, MD. They resided in Longwoods, Stevensville, New York City and Washington, D.C. In 1937 she and her family were selected to be one of the first residents in the new federally constructed planned community of Greenbelt, MD, where she resided for the next sixty years. During World War II, she was employed as a government clerk for the U.S. Treasury Department in Washington, D.C., retiring after thirty years. In her retirement years she enjoyed her family, traveling, reading and gardening.

Mr. Slaughter died April 18, 1979.

Mrs. Slaughter is survived by a son, Leo M. Slaughter, Jr. of Front Royal, VA; a daughter, Joanne Slaughter Kellaher of Greenbelt, MD; eleven grandchildren and twenty-one great-grandchildren. A brother, Oliver O. Berry is deceased.

Funeral services will be held on Tuesday, July 27, 2004 at 2:00 PM at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Easton, MD where friends may call one hour prior to the service.

Burial will be at Woodlawn Memorial Park, Easton, MD.
