June Hillock Railey died at Easton Memorial Hospital of a stroke on August 1, 2015, in the company of her family.

Born in The Oranges of New Jersey on June 6, 1930, she moved with her family to Washington, DC, where she attended The Academy of the Holy Cross. She subsequently attended Dean Junior College before graduating from University of Maryland at College Park.

She married her husband, Clayton A. Railey, Jr., on May 8, 1954. In addition to raising five children and two dogs, June worked for a time in the town office where the family lived in Chevy Chase as well as giving tours on the 8th Floor of the State Department. She was an avid tennis player, bridge player, reader (involved in several book clubs), and golfer; she hit a hole-in-one on October 23, 1995, at Talbot Country Club. Her greatest satisfaction was the success of her children and their families.

She is survived by her husband of 61 years, Clayton A., Jr.; children Clayton A., III (Donald), Edward John "Jack" (Katherine), Kathleen Ann (Leendert "Leo"), Mark Hillock (Frances), and Courtney Oliver (John "Jack"); and 11 grandchildren.
