



## June Bryan Roshaven

June 30, 1951 - March 23, 2010

June Bryan Roshaven died on March 23, 2010 after a brief stay at Talbot Hospice House. She was 58 years old.

Born in Easton on June 30, 1951, she was the daughter of Phyllis Jean Haddaway and the late, James F. Haddaway, Jr. Mrs. Roshaven graduated from St. Michaels High School as a member of the class of 1970. After her children were born, she began working for the family business, Bryan Brothers Garden Center, in St. Michaels. She received her real estate license in the mid 1980s, and began working in the time share industry in Ocean City. She continued her career in Williamsburg, VA, Atlantic City, NJ, and Orlando, FL, where she was living when she was diagnosed with cancer. Mrs. Roshaven then returned to Easton to be with her family. She remained strong and courageous, and never complained during her illness.

She was an excellent golfer. She also enjoyed spending time with her family and her dogs (shih tzus), Jordan and Gizmo.

In addition to her mother, she is survived by her children, Dawn Turner and her husband, Ryan, and James M. "Jamie" Bryan, III and his girlfriend, Sydney Greenish; her siblings, Brenda Woolman and her husband, David, Daniel Haddaway, and Kimberly Bonner; her grandchildren, John Richard "Ricky" Coulby, Jr., Anna Marion Turner, and Chloe L. Turner; several nieces

and nephews and her beloved dogs, Jordan and Gizmo. She was preceded in death by her loving husband, Brian Roshaven.
