Justin Marc “Robo” Todd of Denton, MD, died Sunday, January 15, 2017, he was 32 years old.

Born on January 13, 1985, in Prince George’s County, MD, he is the son of Irvin L. Todd and Patricia Money Lowman. Robo grew up in Prince George’s, Anne Arundel, and Queen Anne’s counties. He worked as a cook at Big Bats Café in Stevensville, for Reliable Contracting, and, most recently, he was working as a heavy equipment operator with his father’s company, East Coast Shoring, Inc. in Denton, MD. Robo loved kids and football, especially the Dallas Cowboys.

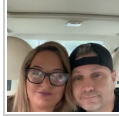

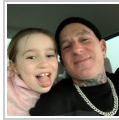

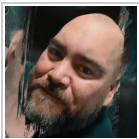
