J. Wilson Clark of Centreville, MD died on Monday, July 26, 2010 at Washington Hospital Center, Washington, DC. He was 83.

Born October 22, 1926 in Centreville, MD, he was the son of the late, Dulin Oliver and Gladys Morgan Clark. Wilson Clark was a native of the Eastern Shore, he spent the first 45 years of his life, farming in the Centreville area and then transitioned to Land Development where he was responsible for providing single family homes and lots to hundreds of families.

His interest included, harness racing, hunting, playing cards, delivering produce and most compassionately helping his fellow man.

His activities included memberships in Queen Anne County Farm Bureau, the US Trotting Association and the Delaware Standardbred Association.

He was pre-deceased by his wife, the former, Kathryn D. Anastasi Clark on July 10, 2009.

Mr. Clark is survived by a son, Capt. James B. Clark, USN, Retired of Stevensville, MD; a daughter, Kathy Clark Coursey and her husband, John Coursey of Centreville, MD; a brother, David Clark of Centreville, MD; two grandchildren, Pvt. Dane Phillip Walls, USMC and Ryan Wilson Walls.

In addition to his wife and parents, he was pre-deceased by four brothers, Cromwell Clark, Leon Clark, Donald Clark and Marvin Clark and a sister, Adrienne Spence.
