Kaitlin Elizabeth Gorrow passed peacefully Thursday, January 22, 2026. She was the daughter of William and Barbara Gorrow, their most precious gift. Though her life was a brief thirty-seven years, she packed a lot of living into them.

She was a perpetual learner and researcher having earned several degrees: a BS in Sociology from Franklin and Marshall College, a BS in Psychology from Wesley College, an MS in Forensic Psychology from Marymount University, and finally an RN from Chesapeake College. Her most recent assignment was as a labor and delivery nurse at Christiana Care in Newark, DE.

Kaitlin was an adventurer having traveled alone to Japan twice. She will continue her adventures by having her ashes spread in the Nordic waters.
