Karl Vaughn Kinder of Rock Hall, MD died on April 5, 2026. He was 61. He was born in Prospect Park, PA on October 13, 1964, the son of the late Theodore and Mary Margaret Byrne Kinder.

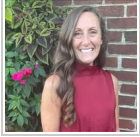
