



## Kate R. Springs

May 12, 1917 - November 26, 2011

Kate R. Springs died on November 26, 2011. She was 94.

Mrs. Springs was born in New York City where she attended private schools and The Art Students League. During World War II, she worked as an artist at the Animation branch of the Army Signal Corps Photographic Center. When the war ended, she became an advertising copy writer. She was among the first to switch from writing print ads to creating television commercials.

In 1960, she married Richard A. Springs, Jr., and moved to Mt. Kisco, NY. While living in Mt. Kisco, Mrs. Springs founded the Northern Westchester Branch of Project Hope, an organization that funded the operation of the hospital ship Hope that traveled to third world countries to teach and heal.

Mrs. Springs and her husband moved to Royal Oak in 1969, where he died in 1990. She was on the first board of Historic Easton and a member of the Historical Society, The Academy of the Arts, The Harbor Club, The Princeton Club of New York, and a past member of the Garden Club of the Eastern Shore.

She is survived by a nephew, Michael M. Rosenberg, CBE.

A memorial service will be private.
