Katherine Jane Savercool Dixon of Chestertown, Maryland died on March 8, 2007 at Chester River Hospital Center. She was 60.

Born in South Bend, Indiana on November 3, 1946, she was the daughter of the late, Joseph and Jeanne Van Dien Savercool.
