



Katherine Poe Duer

June 13, 1931 - September 14, 2022

Katherine "Kitty" Poe Duer of Easton, MD, died on September 14, 2022, at Bayleigh Chase. She was 91 years old.

She was born in Baltimore, MD, on June 13, 1931, to Edgar Allan Poe, Jr. and Katherine Richards Poe. She attended Garrison Forest School in Owings Mills, MD.

Kitty was a sales representative for handmade designer clothing for Doncaster for over 15 years. She and Nancy Trippe were the top sales team for Doncaster. Her loves, besides her family, were hunting for great antique deals at Nelson's Auction House; her dogs; and playing bridge and dominos. She attended Christ Church of Easton and was very involved in the Christ Church rummage sale for decades. She was a member of Green Springs Valley Hunt Club in Owings Mills; the Talbot Country Club in Easton; and The Harbor Club in Easton.

She married John Marshall Morgan, the father of her children. That marriage ended in divorce. She married Charlie Molesworth in 1968 and lived happily for 16 years until his death in 1985. Adgate Duer and Kitty, lifelong friends, fell in love and married in 1993, and lived a wonderful life filled with friends and parties until Ad's death in 2015. Kitty embraced everyone from all three marriages into one large family. She was the beloved "Memom" to all. Just this

past June, her family gathered in Rehoboth Beach in June 2022 for a week-long celebration of her 91st birthday.

Kitty was predeceased by her parents; her brother, Edgar Allan Poe, III; her daughters, Katherine Lee Morgan McDonough and Mary Alricks Morgan; her husbands, Adgate Duer (2015) and Charles Molesworth (1985); her stepsons, Robert Molesworth and Charles Molesworth, Jr.; a step-daughter-in-law, Barbara Molesworth; and a step-grandson Charles Molesworth III (Chip).

Kitty embraced everyone from all three marriages and joined them into one big family. She is survived by her son, John Marshall Morgan of Wilmington, NC; grandsons, Joshua Brent Geib (Christina) of Boynton Beach, FL, John Stewart McDonough (Christine) of Plymouth Meeting, PA, and Matthew Lee McDonough (Dawn) of Wilmington, DE; granddaughter, Katherine Elizabeth Jones (Richard) of Easton, MD; son-in-law, Stewart McDonough (Barbara) of Elkins Park, PA; sister-in-law, Chris Poe of Timonium, MD; cousin, Dickie Swisher, of San Diego, CA; step-daughter, Judith Molesworth Darnell (Larry) of Felton, CA, Margaret Duer Singh (Harsharon) of Columbia, MD, and Bo Duer Price (David) of Ferrisburg, VT; step-son Adgate Duer, Jr.; step-daughter in-law, Nancy Molesworth of Fuquay Varina, NC; eight step-grandchildren; eight great-grandchildren; and ten step-grandchildren.
