



Katherine Anthony Thompson

November 20, 1918 - December 26, 2012

Katherine Beatrix Anthony Thompson, of Centreville, MD, died on December 26, 2012. She was 94 years old. She was born near Centreville on November 20, 1918 to the late I. Hill Anthony and Beatrix Cannon Anthony.

She graduated from Centreville High School in 1935 and Salisbury Teachers College in 1939. Mrs. Thompson taught in Anne Arundel and Queen Anne's County schools. She had been married to the late Lt. Henry C. Lewis who was lost in World War II.

She is predeceased by her husband, J. West Thompson, Jr.

She is survived by two daughters, Nancy A. Lewis of Greenbelt, MD and Sandra L. Metz and her husband, Henry, of New Castle, DE; one son, James W. Thompson III and his wife, Mary Ann, of Centreville; two grandsons, Charles Metz of Buford, GA, and John Metz, of Wilmington, DE; two granddaughters, Kate Walters of Ridgely, MD, and Nancy Bickling of Waynesboro, VA; four great-grandsons, John Metz, Jr., Luke Metz, Hunter Walters and Kole Bickling; and four great-granddaughters, Sarah Metz, Kelsey Walters, Ansley Metz and Delaney Bickling.

Mrs. Thompson was a member of the Centreville United Methodist Church. She had been active in community and school related organizations. She was a charter member of the Goodwill Fire Company Ladies' Auxiliary and served as that organization's first secretary. She had been a volunteer at the Regional Cancer Center in Easton and a member of Delta Kappa Gamma Society, International. She was also a former member of the Kent Island Yacht Club Ladies' Auxiliary.

Funeral services will be held at 2:00pm on Sunday, December 30, at the Centreville United Methodist Church where friends and family may call one hour prior to the service. Burial will be in Chesterfield Cemetery.
