



## Katherine A. Haslup

August 21, 1921 - October 27, 2008

Katherine A. "Kathy" Haslup died on Monday, October 27, 2008 at Foulk Manor South, Wilmington, DE. She was 87.

Born August 21, 1921 in Baltimore, MD, she was the daughter of the late Harry and Edna Pentz Young. She was a 1939 graduate of Eastern High School. In 1946 she married Charles L. Haslup, Jr. and they made their home in Baltimore. In 1964 they moved to Easton, MD where she worked at Memorial Hospital as an EKG Technician until her retirement. Mr. Haslup died September 8, 1984.
