March 28, 1938 - October 16, 2011

Kathleen Kerns Hein of Chestertown, MD, formerly of Sudlersville, MD, died Sunday, October 16, 2011, at her home in Chestertown, MD. She was 73.

Kathleen K. Hein, "Kitty" was born March 28, 1938, in Indiana, PA, the daughter of the late Chester M. Kerns and Eleanor "Troutman." Mrs. Hein received her associate's degree from Towson State Teachers College and worked as a secretary for the Department of Defense at Annapolis, MD, from 1960 to 1964.

On October 16, 1962, she married her husband of 49 years, Allen Manden Hein, Jr. In 1971, they moved to the Eastern Shore near Sudlersville, MD, and remained there until she and Al moved to Chestertown in 2005.
