



Kathleen S. Pusey

July 29, 1924 - January 13, 2015

Kathleen Smithson Pusey passed away on January 13, 2015, at Bayleigh Chase in Easton, MD. She was 90.

Mrs. Pusey was born on July 29, 1924, in Belair, MD. She was the daughter of the late William Preston Smithson and Mary Susannah Nelson. Kathleen graduated from Salisbury State Teachers College (now the University of Maryland at Salisbury). After receiving her degree in education, she taught elementary school in Aberdeen and continued as a substitute teacher for many years. She married Clarence Crane Pusey, II. As the wife of a Naval officer, she moved to Utah in the early 1950s, and returned to Falls Church, VA, where she lived until Mr. Pusey's retirement.

In 1982, they moved to Oxford, where she was an active volunteer in the community. Her interests included the Tred Avon Players, the Easton Choral Society, the Oxford Library, the Customs House, and the commission shop for Memorial Hospital at Easton. She also served on the Altar Guild at the Church of the Holy Trinity and sang in the church choir. She was a member of the Tred Avon Yacht Club and the Talbot County Country Club.

Mrs. Pusey is survived by her daughters, Karen Pusey Fox and husband, Joseph B. Fox, III, and Michele Pusey Lipman and husband, David R. Lipman; grandchildren, Joseph B. Fox, IV, Kathleen Crane Fox and Aron Michael

Lipman; and great grandchildren, Olivia Morgan Fox and Beatrice Dillon Fox; and her sister, Louise Smithson Dulaney. She was preceded in death by her husband, Clarence Crane Pusey, II.

A memorial service will be held on Saturday, February 14, 2015, at 10 a.m. at the Church of the Holy Trinity in Oxford.
