



Kathleen Marie Rogers

September 29, 1949 - July 3, 2024

In the late afternoon of July 3rd, 2024, Kathie Rogers unexpectedly but peacefully passed away. She is survived by her beloved husband, Charles "Chuck" Troutmann, precious dog Gatsby, her brother Tom Rogers, and niece Rachel Rogers.

Kathie was born in Pittsburgh Pennsylvania and had a fulfilling career as a paralegal for Wiley Rein and Fielding in Washington DC, and then Odin, Feldman, Pittleman in Fairfax Virginia.

Kathie always loved telling the story of how she found and married Chuck, the love of her life, in 2005 in Las Vegas. They were married by "Elvis". After living in Virginia for many years, they moved to the town of Easton, Maryland to further enjoy their life together.

An accomplished artist in oil painting, Kathie was a member of the Working Artists Forum and St. Michaels Art League. Her beautiful paintings were displayed in a variety of shows, art galleries, libraries and restaurants on the Eastern Shore, including Rehoboth Delaware and Ocean City Maryland, as well as Washington DC, Fairfax and Vienna, Virginia. She showed at the annual Local Color Art Exhibition during Plain Aire in Easton, and the street Banner Program in St. Micheals.

Kathie's love of animals, gardening, and playing cards with the ladies was abundant. She was passionate about cooking (using Chuck as a guinea pig for new recipes) and loved to entertain friends.

As a devoted parishioner of All Faith Chapel in Tunis Mills, Kathie's energy, compassion and devotion to volunteering will be truly missed.
