



## Kathleen McCarty Unti

July 7, 1944 - September 2, 2021

Kathleen McCarty Unti passed away on September 2, 2021, at her home. She was 77.

She was born on July 7, 1944, in Detroit, Michigan, the daughter of the late William and Frances Brinker McCarty.

Kathy married Walter Unti in 1965 and they made their home in Ann Arbor, Michigan where his was going to school.

Kathy received her Dental Hygiene Degree from the University of Detroit and used it to work in Michigan, Pennsylvania, and Florida.

After graduating from Aquinas College with a business degree in 1985, she started her own real estate firm in Grand Rapids, Michigan.

Kathy was a hospice volunteer for 35 years, starting in Grand Rapids, MI, then Harrisburg, PA, then Sonoma, CA, and finally at Talbot Hospice in Easton, MD. She also enjoyed volunteering as a docent at the Sonoma Bouvier Preserve where she took fifth graders on hikes.

Her sister, Patricia was an Adrian Dominican Sister, so she became an Adrian Dominican Associate and worked with other associates to support the communities work with the needy.
